Multi Service Center (MSC)

Department of Human Service Programs

MSC distributes housing and housing related information to Cambridge households. The MSC also serves as a primary point of contact for unhoused residents to receive services and housing assistance.

The MSC staff assist residents with:

- Applying for public benefits
- Funding for eviction prevention
- Housing Search workshops
- Referrals to financial counseling and legal services
- Access to mental health and substance abuse services

The MSC's Haitian Services staff provide case management and immigration counseling to people who have relocated from Haiti and limited service to other residents.

The Housing Division offers access to homeownership and rental opportunities for low-moderate and middle-income households.

Programs include:

- Inclusionary Rental Housing Program
- Middle Income Rental Program
- Homeownership Resale Pool
- HomeBridge
- First-time homebuyer lotteries
- Homebuyer education

The Housing Division also offers low-interest financing through the Home Improvement Program to assist eligible homeowners make needed home repairs.
